

HOW TO MAKE A POLLUTION CATCHER

See how much pollution is in your air!

FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS TO CREATE YOUR OWN POLLUTION CATCHER AND SEE HOW MUCH POLLUTION IS IN YOUR AIR! LEAVE IT FOR A DAY, A WEEK, OR A MONTH AND SEE WHAT YOU FIND!



SUPPLIES:

- Paper plate
- Hole punch
- Yarn/string
- Vaseline (petroleum jelly)
- Markers/crayons

WHERE SHOULD IT GO?

- By a window
- Outside
- At your desk
- By the door
- Near the A/C or heater

1. PREP YOUR PLATE

Before you get started, you can decorate the back side of your plate with a picture of a beautiful, clean Earth!

2. PUNCH IT OUT

Punch two holes near the top of your plate. Thread the yarn through to make a loop you can hang it with!

3. SMOOTH IT OUT

Cover the front side of your plate with a generous amount of Vaseline (petroleum jelly).

4. HANG IT UP

Hang your pollution catcher up and check in to see how much pollution you can catch!

What should you expect? After some time (how long depends on where your plate is) you will see air pollution catching in the Vaseline! Hang multiple plates up and test to see which area has the most air pollution!
