Start your own garden!

DID YOU KNOW THAT EGG CARTONS ARE BIODEGRADABLE? USING AN OLD EGG CARTON (WITH OR WITHOUT THE EGG SHELLS) IS A GREAT WAY TO START A GARDEN IN YOUR CLASSROOM. READY TO PLANT IT? PUT THE WHOLE THING IN THE GROUND AND WATCH IT GROW!



SUPPLIES:

- Recycled egg carton
- Optional: clean egg shells
- Soil
- Seeds

WHAT TO PLANT?

- Bell peppers
- Tomatoes
- Basil
- Cilantro
- Mint
- Beans
- Cucumbers
- Sunflowers

1.

CLEAN, CLEAN, CLEAN!

Before starting, make sure your egg carton has no egg on it. If you are choosing to use egg shells, clean them well.

2.

FILL 'EM UP

Fill each cup of the carton up with soil.

3.

PLANT YOUR SEEDS

Place the seeds in the soil. Make sure they are covered and well placed.

4.

MAKE IT RAIN!

Water your seeds and place them in a sunny area!

Note: This is a great activity for young kids! Egg cartons aren't fragile like pots and are easy to find. Plant some seeds, let the kids water them, and see them grow!
